Lakeland Players, a member of the Community Theatre Association of Michigan (CTAM), is pleased to offer a scholarship recognizing one student's contribution to Theatre Arts. This scholarship is for \$500.00 and is non-renewable; the scholarship award will be paid directly to the college of the student's choice. This scholarship is given in the memory of one of our dearest members, Mr. Jack McCaffrey, a founding member of Lakeland Players and long-time teacher in the Waterford School System.

Applications will be accepted from members of Lakeland Players only.

The Scholarship Committee is comprised of members of Lakeland Players and their decisions are final. The Scholarship Committee will be looking at the following criteria:

- a) involvement in theatre activities (both at school and at community levels)
- b) recommendations from directors, supervisors or teachers familiar with the student's
- c) theatrical involvement
- d) contributions to theatre in general
- e) other training/experiences, including acting, dance, voice, instrumental, music, technical
- f) theatre, or theatre management

In case of all things being equal, the Scholarship Committee will look at the following criteria to break ties:

- a) high school grades
- b) your plans for future participation in theatre activities

If necessary, the committee may also conduct personal interviews to break a tie.

The application for this scholarship is enclosed and please feel free to attach additional sheets as necessary. High importance will be placed on attached letters of recommendation from appropriate theatre directors, supervisors and teachers. It is important to submit all parts of the application at the same time.
