Read before signing Form # 3 – Camper Contract**

1. The Guest Group shall assist in placing in order all facilities it has occupied or used upon departure. The Guest Group Leaders are expected to maintain order of their group at all times and prevent damage to Central United Methodist Church (CUMC) property.

4. Respect others and their property.
5. Breach of this covenant will result in immediate revocation of camp privileges. No part of the Total Reservation Fee shall be refunded.
